Committee Reports:

Field Day 2023: The committee met at the proposed field day site for 2023. Lincoln Middle School will allow us to hold our event in their parking lot in Shinnston this year to hopefully attract more public visitors. It looks like this will be the set venue for the 2023 event.Ed and Rodd Tenney got together and repaired the donated Cushcraft beam used at Field Day.

Executive Council Minutes May 9, 2023

Call to Order:


